Our Mission

The mission of the Foundation in Canada is to support women living with cancer through the Look Good Feel Better® program and to help women who experience domestic violence by providing grants to women's shelters and community outreach programs. The MKACF raises funds to support these programs through the sale of fundraising items and events, as well as donations made by the independent sales force, corporate staff and consumers.

99% of donations directly support Look Good Feel Better® and programs to eliminate violence against women.

That means just 1% of your donation goes to administrative expenses.

Making Women Feel More Like Themselves Again

Look Good Feel Better is Canada's only national charitable program dedicated to helping women manage the appearance-related effects of cancer and its treatment.

At the heart of the program is a complimentary two-hour workshop which provides advice on managing dry and sensitive skin, the loss of brows and lashes, uneven skin tone and makeup hygiene. The program also provides a demonstration on hair alternatives such as wigs and scarves and in select workshops, breast care options for women post-surgery.

Even more, Look Good Feel Better provides psycho-social support, offering women a welcoming environment, where they can spend some much-needed time on themselves and connect with other women going through a similar experience.

Look Good Feel Better reaches more than 10,000 women each year. Since COVID-19, they have incorporated virtual workshops into their programming, in addition to hosting workshops in 110 hospitals and cancer centres across Canada, delivered by 1300 industry-trained volunteers – many of them Mary Kay Independent Beauty Consultants.

Turning Belief Into Action

Mary Kay Ash believed that motivation, recognition and unlimited opportunity could transform women and empower them to achieve a better life for themselves and their families. Sadly, one in three women in Canada today will be the victim of violence during her lifetime. Domestic violence, rape, stalking and murder threaten and destroy women's dreams, their families and – too often – their lives.

Since 2004, the MKACF has awarded over \$1.7 million through its annual Shelter Grant program, supporting over 140 women's shelters and community outreach programs nationwide that aid victims of domestic violence.

The MKACF invites you to join the effort to reach out to women affected by domestic violence. We encourage you to educate yourself about the issue; to be an informed listener; to seek help when there is a need. Most of all, we encourage you to break the silence. Only when the silence is broken can help be found and lives changed.

Who's At Risk?

It could be your sister, your mother, your friend. It could even be you. It's alarming to know that in a lifetime, one in two women will develop some form of cancer, and one in three women will be a victim of violence. By helping one another, we can make a difference in these statistics.

Since its inception, the Foundation has raised **MORE THAN \$3.36 million** to support women impacted by domestic violence and cancer. This year, our goal is to support Look Good Feel Better with a donation of \$125,000, and to support shelters across Canada with \$144,000 in donations through our annual Shelter Grant program.
